



PRIVACY POLICY STATEMENT

POLICY

The Western Australian Speedway Commission (the Commission) has established this Privacy Policy Statement to protect members' privacy and personal information that it may collect from time to time.

Who Is WA Speedway Commission?

The Commission is a non-profit association and appointed governing body. It is the recognised State Sporting Association for Speedway in WA.

The WASC is a democratically formed body made up of a Board of Commissioners, Advisory Committees the General Manager and administrative support.

What Business Are We In?

The Commission was established in March 2000 to implement and monitor the safety standards in the sport of speedway, in Western Australia.

The WASC does this through the delivery of the State Government supported Safety Governance Framework.

The Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries (DLGSC) is a major supporter of the Commission and its work. The Commission works closely with the Department and the WA Speedway community to ensure that risk management and duty of care best practices are implemented by its affiliate members and their membership base.

Collecting your Personal Information

The Commission understands that members may have concerns about their privacy and the confidentiality and security of information that the Commission may obtain about them.

The Commission's policy is to protect members' privacy and personal information that it may collect from time to time. This includes storing personal information securely with password protection in place. Minimising access to personal records. Not sharing personal information with third parties without your consent.

Confidentiality deed

All Commissioners, Committee Members and employees are required to sign and adhere to the WASC Confidentiality Deed and WASC Code of Conduct which prohibits inappropriate information sharing.

The Commission has undertaken to comply with the requirements of the *Privacy Act, 1988* and the National Privacy Principles included in the *Privacy Act (Private Sector) Amendment Act 2000*.
